Short Bio: Constantina Skanavis is a Professor in Environmental Communication and Education at the Department of Public and Community Health at the University of West Attica. She is also the Head of the Research Module of Environmental Education and Communication. Professor Skanavis served as the first Dean of the University's School of Public Health. Furthermore, Professor Constantina Skanavis is the Chair of the newly offered Master of Science program in Environmental Communication and Health Promotion. Prior to her position at University of West Attica, she was a member of the academic community of the University of the Aegean for 18 years. Constantina Skanavis received her doctoral degree from the University of Los Angeles, School of Public Health and upon graduation her first position as a Professor, took place at California State University, Los Angeles and lasted for 12 years. Then she moved to Greece. She has developed several courses on issues of environmental communication and education and health promotion. Professor Skanavis has numerous publications on an international basis and has given presentations all over the world. Professor Skanavis is the co-founder of Skyros Project an innovative environmental awareness program with over 8,000 followers.
