She teaches courses in Meteorology, Atmospheric Pollution and Climate Change, at undergraduate and postgraduate level. Her research interests include urban meteorology, bioclimatology, atmospheric pollution, environmental epidemiology, climate change and its impact on the natural environment and public health. She has >100 publications in peer reviewed journals, conference proceedings and book chapters (SCOPUS h index: 22). She has participated in numerous national/European research projects as PI or team leader. She is the author of 2 textbooks (Climate Change, Physics of the Atmospheric Environment). As of 2020, she serves as Associate Editor in the scientific journal "Science of the Total Environment" (ELSEVIER publications, IF=10.753).
